FINANCIAL REPORT: Gene Evans, Treasurer, gave the Financial Report. The balance as of December 19, 2019 is \$19,757.41 of which \$1525.00 is restricted for the Garden and \$500.00 is restricted for benches. The **expense ratio is 7.8%,** 5% of which is Insurance. The report was approved by Members without change.
