

“New” Help Me Please DAILY CHECK-IN Program for Cresswind Residents who Live Alone

1. **The Daily Check- In Program** will be managed in Cresswind by **Jan Cieply**, Help Me Please volunteer with **Bud Baker** Help Me Please Manager as her backup. This new service is one that will be offered to Cresswind residents *primarily for singles (if needed also couples)* who would like someone that they can contact daily to let them know that all is well. You've all heard horror stories of single home-dwellers who have fallen and been unable to receive help for days.

2. Operationally, after the resident has signed up for the program they will be given a Help Me Please (HMP) volunteer's phone number to call or text each day at an agreed upon time to let the HMP volunteer know they are OK.

If the HMP volunteer receives this phone call (or text) that all is well, then no one needs to do anything else that day.

3. **If the Help Me Please volunteer does not receive an "OK", "I'm Fine",** call (or text) or any other indication from the resident, *then the resident will be called to ensure they are OK.*

If there is no answer, the volunteer will contact one of the emergency numbers given on the resident "intake" form. If unable to reach either of the emergency contact numbers, the HMP team leader will be notified and one or both will visit the resident to ensure that all is well.

If there is no answer when they ring the doorbell, then they will utilize the garage keypad or the resident's key to gain entry to the house (pre provided / agreed upon by the resident).

Once inside, a call to 911 will be made, if necessary.
